


Interment Space

Interment Space

When you purchase an interment space, you are purchasing “interment rights”, meaning the right to designate who may be interred in the space. Interment rights include the right to place a memorial and flower vase where permitted. Right of interment may be purchased for full casket space or cremated remains

Burial Vault

This is an outer burial container that encases the casket. Vaults provide protection for the casket and prevent the interment space from sinking. An outer burial container is required for all burials.

The Memorial

Memorials pay tribute to a life and identify the interment space. Usually constructed of bronze or granite.

Interment Fees

The interment fee includes the following: administration, permanent record keeping and documentation, opening and closing of the grave, interment set up, leveling and maintenance of the grave, supplies and other services.

Cost Factors

Your cost depends on several factors including:

1. The location of the interment space you choose;
2. The type of vault you choose;
3. The kind of memorial you want; and
4. The time you make your purchase.

As time goes by, inflation pushes prices up. But you can avoid higher costs in the future by making your selections now.
